- 8. Joel Henry Zumwalt Benevolent Society:

Is looked after by, Loren Wilson, Eddy Hawkens, Mike Eckley, Tanner Boone, and Jim Lillie. Request to use ECV with. WOCO, Boone's Memorial is in Murphy's.

They would like funding for wall repairs and maintenance, Angels Camp Museum ECV display & ECV Clamper display at the Old Timers Museum, in addition with donations acquired from within the ECV brotherhood to help preserve its existence. Joel Henry Zumwalt burial site is at Protestant cemetery in Mokelumne Hill, CA. They will make sure that the grave is kept up and clean.

## 9. CARP:

Mike Eckley was present, explained that they oversee Hawkers with the trademark. The BOP to tell members to not use others' art work. Liam asked if CARP could tell all the Hawkers and Chapters present at the CARP meeting to not let people sell for profit. Not let people even set up at their events that are for profit.

## 10. Humbug 73:

Humbug 73 is shorthanded, has 8 active members. Has all their paperwork up to date and active insurance. With a check in hand to GC. Mark suggested that maybe in the future that they think about a merger possibly with one of the neighboring chapters.

## 11. Outpost reports:

## 9.1 YB1 with Historical Society Chief Solano 1851:

Had supporting NGH's or surrounding areas, areas not from all over and many more members, filled half the room. Dennis Moore NGH of YB1 asked for Outpost. Historical Society Chief Solano were asked some questions before leaving. The support group was so large that they could NOT get out the door in a timely manner.

#### 9.2 Matuca with John C Fremont 1854:

Working on building their bank up. Has one plaque with Matuca. They are working on about five other plaque ideas. Having good attendance. Meeting once a month. Members 118, meetings up to 35. Thought they were doing good and thanks the BOP for the time to check in with them on their progress.

## 9.3 Major William Downie 1849 with Pio Pico 1801:

Had NGH & XNGH's from supporting chapters present. Chris Hale from Pio Pico 1801 spoke. Had 12 new people from their territory they brought in over the last year with couple events. Pio Pico 1801 did 5 plaques fo r & with Major William

Downie 1849. Also did a plaque at 4way doins with Major William Downie 1849, San Brannan 1004, & John Sutter 1841. Donated \$500 to GC to funding as they see fit to use for.

## 9.4 Umpqua Joe 1859 with Sam Barlow 33:

Had Doc Maynard 54-40, Lassen-Loomis 1914, Trinitarianus 62 present in support. Umpqua Joe ask for Sam Barlow to move up. They had a plague together at their joint doins. Sam Barlow has two more plague coming this year in their territory. They have 10-15 members at the meetings. XSNGH Dan McCormick spoke about Sam Barlow 33 and how good they were doing.

## 12. Outpost Progression Discussion.

#### Chief Solano 1851:

Liam recommended that they be asked to come back next year. Dave & Liam both agreed they have gotten a lot better in the last 3 years. Paul talked about the finances. Lyle wants to ask them to bring better paperwork details. Ray moved Dave 2<sup>nd</sup> to move them to Outpost Fledgling. Some discussion, PASSED.

## John C Fremont 1854:

Discussion was had. Group is working to build things up. Looking good for the future. Ray moved to ask them to come back next year, Justin 2<sup>nd</sup>. PASSED

#### Pio Pico 1801:

Liam moved & Paul 2<sup>nd</sup> to move up Fledgling to Provisional. Discussion was had. LOST Dave moved with Ray 2<sup>nd</sup> for them to stay at Fledgling. PASSED

#### Sam Barlow 33:

Justin wants to see them continue with new leader and hopes for them to continue to grow. Lyle also would like to see them grow more. Justin moved & Lyle 2<sup>nd</sup> for them to stay at Provisional. Some more discussion was had. PASSED

#### 13. CARP/ Hawker's

Brandon talked about hawkers having problems and people hawking for profit, asked what does CARP do/offer. Dave said that CARP helps with safe guard of other people's art. Liam talked about hawking for profit and not hawking for a chapter, this takes money away revenue away from chapters. Lyle reminded the Board that 11-8-21 CARP was sent a letter asking for better rules/guidelines and we never were submitted any. After further

discussion since Grand Council is the trademark holder and protectors of the order, that they would make a small committee to establish rules & guidelines.

#### 14. General Discussion:

## Joel Zumwalt Group:

After discussion with the Board a motion was made to ask them to affiliate with an ECV Chapter as they are not a Chapter or an Outpost. Dave moved Ray 2<sup>nd</sup>, PASSED

## WCOC/Wall of Comparative Ovation Committee:

Mark wants them to send in quarterly reports to the SNGR. We were told the new people at the WCOC like the wall but would also like us to maintain it. Justin moved with Dave 2<sup>nd</sup> to have a proctor on the committee, with a \$200 cap of not asking for monies but still need to have a real receipt, with quarterly reports. PASSED Jeff was asked and accepted to be the proctor liaison.

Brandon reminded Chapters that they are allowed to tell people to not hawk for profit at their doins and or ant events. Letting people hawk for profit is taking away from ECV hawkers that are trying to make money for their chapters and it takes away from money that your own Hawker could be making for your Chapter!

Question was asked about "TRANS" coming to Chapter events. Wants Grand Council to make a stand. Brandon reminded them that when it is your Chapter event you are allowed to not let them in. We are a Men's club. Not if you are identifying as a man. In turn if you are a man but want to identify as a woman you are allowed to not let them in. We can do it nicely. We do not have to be mean about it.

Eureka 101 Chapter is asking for donations to help the Chapter with legal fees to help keep their 1931 fire truck in the Chapter!

## 16. BOP talks.

The question came up about Hawking for profit. Liam explained that Gary Gates was out currently selling at Grand Council for profit. Brandon stated that we do not have it in writing or rules from CARP. After some discussion it was all agreed upon that only Chapter Hawkers that all proceeds going to the Chapter should have ECV, or be allowed to sell at ECV because we are a historical society that as none profit. Liam said all of us do not volunteer our time for others to profit off us.
