Directions to the Clampsite

Directions from the Reno Area:

Follow I-80 East for 500+ miles to exit 117, for I-215 North. Follow the signs and continue on to I-215 North (Ogden, UT). Follow I-215 North for approx. 5 miles to exit 26 (Legacy Hwy North). Follow for 12 miles to exit 11 (US-89 Towards Ogden, UT). Take the I-84 East ramp to Morgan, and follow for 27 miles. Take exit 115 (UT-65 South towards Henefer/Echo). Follow for 0.3 miles to South Echo Frontage Road. Turn left on South Echo Frontage road. Follow 1 mile to the Weber Crossing Campground.

Directions from the Los Angeles Area:

Head East to I-15 North. Stay North on I-15 for 500+ miles to exit 263 (US-189/University Ave. Follow for 29 miles and turn left on (US-89/US-40West/South Main St.). Stay straight for 17 miles, and follow signs to (I-80 East/Cheyenne). Continue for 21 miles to exit 168 (I-84 West towards Ogden). Follow 4.2 miles to exit 115 (UT-65 South towards Henefer/Echo). Follow for 0.3 miles to South Echo Frontage Road. Turn left on South Echo Frontage road for 1 mile to the Weber Crossing Campground.

Directions from the Seattle (and pretty much any) Area:

Plug (726 S Frontage Rd, Henefer, UT 84033) into your GPS. Then do what the mean lady tells you to.
