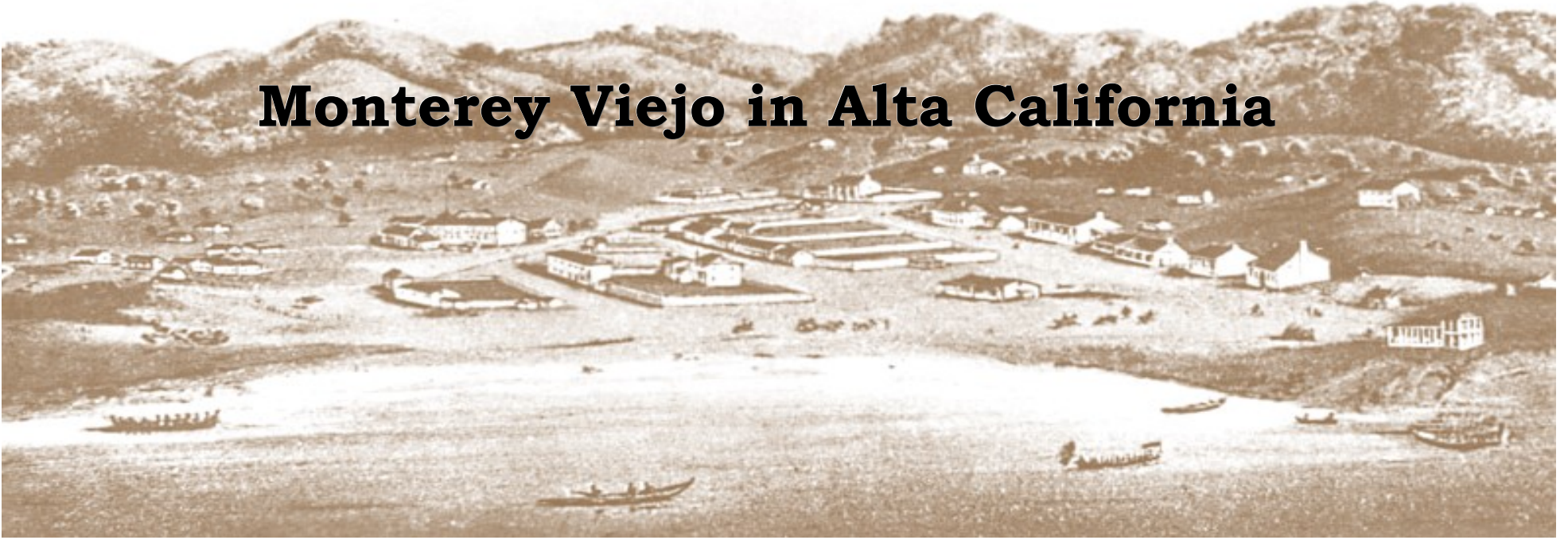

Direction's Heading North

Follow US 101 N to Leavesley Road/Hi 152 W exit and turn left. Follow Leavesley Road approx. .3 miles to Monterey Road and turn right. Take Monterey Road north for approx. 2.7 miles to Rucker Avenue. Turn right on Rucker Ave. and follow for approx. .2 miles. Clampsite will be on your right, located at: 170 Rucker Ave., Gilroy, CA. Please drive slowly and follow all signs and directions – this is a working ranch.

Direction's Heading South

Follow US 101 S to Masten Avenue exit and turn right. Follow Masten Avenue approx. .3 miles to Monterey Road and turn left. Take Monterey Road south for approx. .4 miles to Rucker Avenue. Turn left on Rucker Ave. and follow for approx. .2 miles. Clampsite will be on your right, located at: 170 Rucker Ave., Gilroy, CA. Please drive slowly and follow all signs and directions – this is a working ranch.

Direction's From Fresno

Follow CA 152 W to Ferguson Road and turn right. Follow Ferguson Road approx. 1.3 miles follow it to the left as it turns into Leavesley Road. Follow Leavesley Road approx. .3 miles to Monterey Road and turn right. Take Monterey Road north for approx. 2.7 miles to Rucker Avenue. Turn right on Rucker Ave. and follow for approx. .2 miles. Clampsite will be on your right, located at: 170 Rucker Ave., Gilroy, CA. Please drive slowly and follow all signs and directions – this is a working ranch.

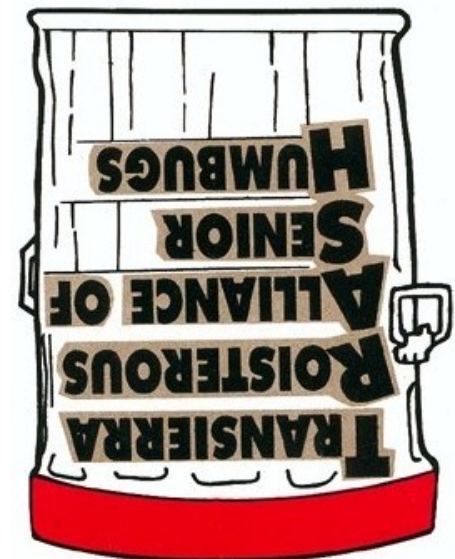
